PRESIDENTS REPORT

Legacy Australia Incorporated AGM and Legacy 2030 Workshop

The CEO and I attended the Legacy 2030 Workshop and the Legacy Australia Inc AGM held at the Park Royal Melbourne Airport on 18-19 October 2022. Representatives from 31 of 45 clubs attended. I will provide an overview of the key outcomes and our perspectives on several other matters to the Member's Meeting on 15 November.

Remembrance Day Representation

I attended the Sydney Legacy Remembrance Day Luncheon on Friday 4 November at the invitation of their President, Legatee Steve Hopwood. The guest speakers included Sandy Macdonald AM, Defence Housing; Michelle Carr, Sydney Legacy; and Dr Brendan Nelson AO, Boeing Australia, New Zealand and South Pacific. The lunch was very well attended and gave me the opportunity to meet several members of Sydney Legacy and LCS.

Bob Lowry, Deputy Chair, will attend and lay a wreath at the RSL Remembrance Day Service at Kibble Park on Friday 11 November 2022 on behalf of Brisbane Water Legacy.

Resignation of John George

Regrettably, I must advise that the Company Secretary received an email from John George on the morning of 21 October advising of his immediate resignation as both a Director and Legatee with BWLC with effect from that date.

I have written to John on behalf of the Board and membership to thank him for his dedicated and selfless service to BWLC over the past six years and also to express my deep and abiding sadness following his departure from the BWLC.

Committee Appointments

Due to the retirement of John George, I have asked Mike Hickey to step into the breach and continue to Chair the Advocacy Committee and he has agreed to do so for the foreseeable future.

In addition, also due to the departure of John George, I have asked Stephen "Beetle" Bailey to Chair the Public Relations Committee for the foreseeable future and he has agreed to do so.

The chairmanship of both committees was confirmed by the Board on 8 November.

COMPANY SECRETARY / CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS REPORT

1. Village

The Village Redevelopment Committee met on 25th October 2022 with our Project Manager (Darren Timms) to discuss options for moving forward.

Darren advised that Grindley have been preparing/obtaining trade quotes for the work and are hitting several roadblocks. This is mainly lack of availability of preferred trades etc, or escalated quotes (20% increase on April 2022).

It apparent that the trade market is overheated. Our QS also confirmed that he is hearing the same message everywhere so the slowdown in new construction starts appears to be happening.

Whilst our DA is approved by NSW Dept Planning, the Central Coast Council are finalising their component which will also take some weeks (they have escalated to progress though). This includes advice on sewer line stabilisation, road works and traffic management plans.

The Committee recommends that Grindley go back to market in February 2023, to review the status.

So effectively we will delay until Q1 2023. we will however progress finalising Construction Certificate documentation, Council requirements etc, so we are prepared and ready to go in 2023.

The committee will continue to appoint a preferred Marketing group for the surplus/subdivided land, which should provide some more informed detail in likely market value. EOI's have been provided by Colliers, CBRE and Frank Knight and will be reviewed by the committee during November 2022.

Staff will continue to relocate the final 3 residents into units on the southern side of the site by December, leaving only the office relocation in early 2023.

2. LA Inc. AGM and Legacy 2030.

The LA Inc AGM was held on 19th October 2022, with all resolutions (as previously communicated with BWLC members) supported. The Minutes and outcomes of the AGM will be distributed shortly.
